

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to mvpllc.com and MVP Construction LLC and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to MVP Construction include mvpllc.com, and MVP. The MVP website is a corporate site. By using the MVP Construction website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

In order to better provide you with products and services offered on our Site, MVP Construction may collect personally identifiable information, such as your:

- First and Last Name
- E-mail Address
- Phone Number
- Employer
- Job Title

MVP Construction may also collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your:

Use of your Personal Information

Sharing Information with Third Parties

MVP Construction does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.
